This year, the Spivack Scholarship Fund awarded scholarships to 15 DCPS students. Since its inception, 53 scholarships have been awarded.

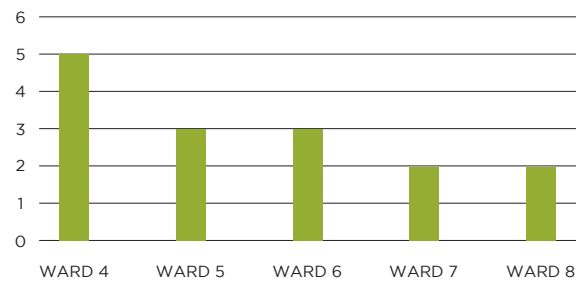
